- ☐ Plant a seed

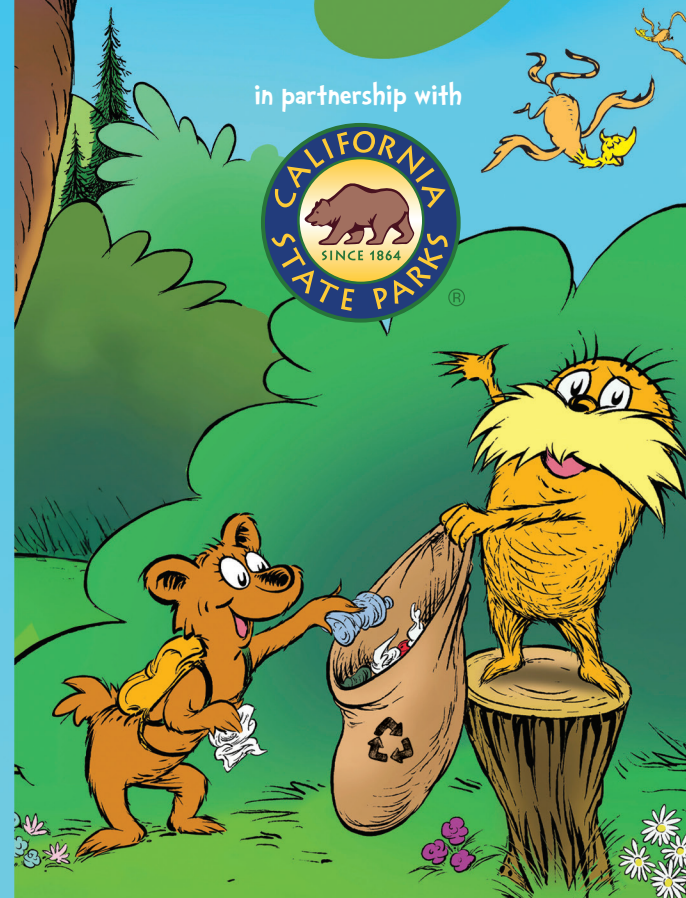
California's state parks are a great place to do these activities. See how many of these activities you can check off during your visit to a state park.

- ☀️ If there's no one else in the room you're in, make sure to turn the light off as you leave.

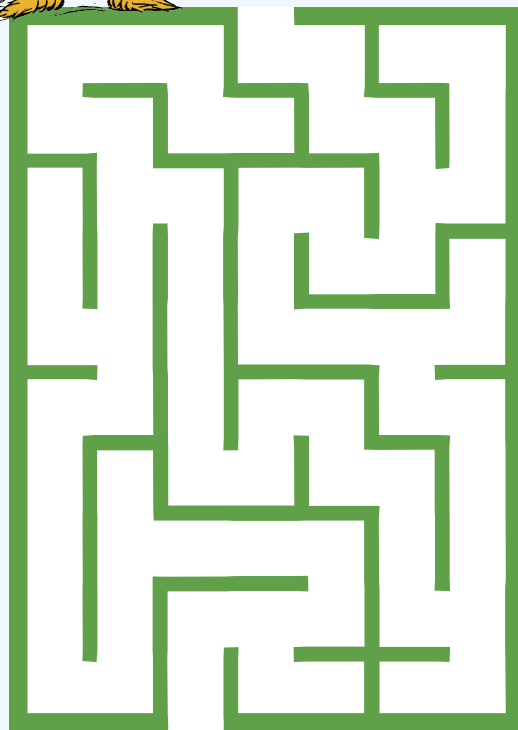
LIMIT YOUR PERSONAL WASTE
